



This is a paper piecing pattern. Finished size: 5" x 5"

Color requirements:

Center piece (#1): White

Remaining pieces: your choice

Lettering: Black (either embroidery or permanent pen)

Embellishment: optional

- Using the paper pattern below to construct your name badge, place square of white fabric, right side up, on back side of paper, being sure to completely cover square #1.
- Align fabric for space #2, right side facing, on white fabric of square #1. Place fabric side down, paper side up and machine stitch, with a small straight stitch, along line between spaces #1 & #2. Turn Fabric #2 right-side up and press.
- Continue adding pieces in numerical order until all 8 pieces have been added.
- Place your first name inside square #1 (unless you embroidered it & it's already there ☺).

- Place "Crazy Quilters of Federal Way" across the bottom of the square as shown in the example above.
- Remove paper.
- Place batting and backing fabric on right side of block. Stitch around the square, leaving an opening to turn right side out. Whip stitch opening.
- Attach fastener to back of block
