If you've never been to a Crazy Quilters retreat, you don't know what you're missing. We have a great big, well-lighted air-conditioned sewing area. The bedrooms have new beds. the area. The lake is within walking distance. The new staff are very accommodating, and working hard to make sure we feel taken care of. Lacey is about a 45 minute drive from Federal Way. We Have A New Meeting Place!

We will be meeting at Christ Lutheran Church – 2501 SW 320th St.

Social time will be 6:15ish or so.

Meeting time will be 6:30 - 8:30pm (so it won't be quite so dark during the winter)

Directions:

Go west on 320th (get there however is convenient for you)

Go straight past 1st Ave South (there's a stoplight there)

Go straight through the stop light at 21st Ave SW.

Go down the slight hill (there are 2 office buildings on your left; homes on the right)

Christ Lutheran Church is on your left (south side of the road) at the bottom of the hill, there are two parking lot entrances and the parking lot is flat!
