## Tying quilts at the Western Wa State Fair

We learned that the Fair would still be doing quilt tying as an exhibit at the Fair in September. We decided, as a group, that we would participate. There were a number of hands that were raised for people who said they would be willing to help in the process of getting that accomplished.

This year we are trying something a little different to get our sign-ups done. You sign yourself up for your chosen date/time and don't have to respond to an email or call somebody to sign you up. There have been a couple of emails with the information, but it's here again......

Eileen set up a SignUp Genius - that way you can see 'right now' what is open and available AND if you want to bring your sister/daughter/friend, you can sign up all at once!

Our DATES are Sept 16th, 19th & 20th! (that's a Monday, Thursday and Friday!)

Sign-up is still at SignUpGenius and Eileen has it ready to go!

Get your choice of dates/times by going there to sign up. It's quick and easy!

Then our "Quilt Tying - Washington State Fair 2019" will show up.

Eileen has set it up with 2 shifts per day with 4 people per shift. Click the little "sign-up" box for the day and time you want. Click the Submit & Sign-Up at the bottom of the page.

The next page shows what you've signed up for. If it's just you, just continue (this is where you'd create an account), fill in and read the rest of the stuff. Then click the "Sign Up Now" button. This will give you a confirmation. And I believe you'll also get a confirmation in September before your date to be at the Fair.

If you want to sign up you and your mom/sister/kidlet, change the number to 2 (or whatever) over in the "quantity" box on the right, and then also please put names in the comment space.

Simple, quick and effective. Much easier than sign-up sheets at the meeting or responding to an email and then finding out the spot you want is filled.
